Cheetahs are carnivores that hunt during the day, typically when it's cooler at dawn or dusk. Their diet consists of the meat of antelope, ground-dwelling birds, rabbits, porcupines, and ostriches. It takes a lot of energy for a cheetah to chase down their prey, so there is typically a recovery period following a chase. Cheetahs must eat quickly to avoid their meal being stolen by other carnivores like lions, vultures or hyenas. Cheetah is fastest land animal in world declared extinct in India in 1952. Human – wildlife conflict is the major threat along with habitat loss, expanded human activities, illegal trade and poaching.

D. P. Bhosale College, Koregaon in collaboration with Department of Forests, Koregaon – Satara has organized lecture on the occasion of **“Reintroduction of Cheetah in India on 17<sup>th</sup> September 2022”**. African Cheetahs are brought under an intercontinental translocation project between India and Africa. On this occasion D. P. Bhosale College, Koregaon has taken initiative in Collaboration with Department of Forests, Koregaon – Satara to create awareness among the students about ecological role of Cheetah to maintain ecosystem equilibrium, the concept behind the reintroduction of Cheetah.

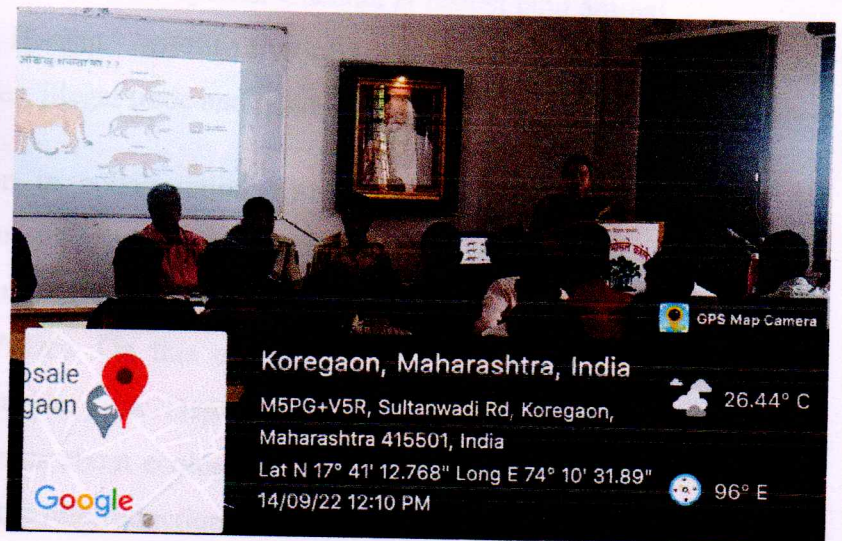
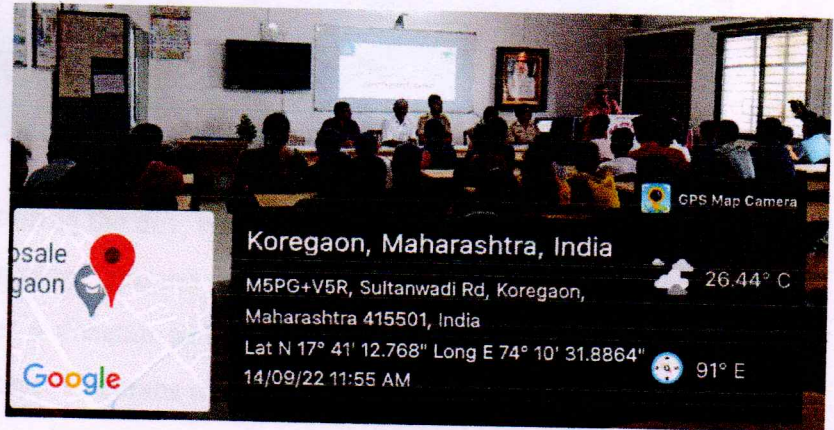
