

## Jangali Jayagad

**Jangali Jayagad** ([Marathi](#): जंगली जयगड किल्ला) is located in [Patan taluka](#) of [Satara District](#).

This fort is situated on a hilly spur from the main ridge of Sahyadri. This fort is less visited due to its occurrence in [Koyana Wildlife sanctuary](#). The nearby village is Nawja. The trek to the fort can easily be completed in a day.

### Places of Interest

The fort is in a very dilapidated condition. There is no main entrance gate, water cistern or caves on the fort. There is an old well and ruins of Devi temple. The path to the fort passes through dense forest. The scats, droppings, hoof marks and pugmarks of various wild animals can be seen. The path is regularly used by wild [Gaur](#) (Bison). The dwindling ghat road to Chiplun can be seen from the fort. The jungle is home to variety of Insects, Birds, reptiles and animals.
