

It is assumed that Colonialism triggered off the **Indian Renaissance** and that one impact of Westernization on literature was to endow it with modernity.

The colonial impact caused the Indian attempt at a grand synthesis of the **East and the West** now termed as **Renaissance** and the assimilation of **Western literary forms** and critical paradigms led to the assertion of self-identity and modern self-awareness in Indian Literature.

Critical theories and trends in the West had originated in their specific local contexts. Their spread through the machinery of the Colonial Education system created a climate of literary views which seems quite absurd.

For example **Thomas Carlyle** and **Charles Lamb** were taught in India as models of prose writing. Drilled in Carlyle and Scott, the Indian writers of **Bhass** literature too started writing in that style, producing prose that was hardly readable.




